- The above described well has declined in oil production to 1 barrel per day plus 60 barrels of water. Production is from the "D" sand.
- It is desired to plug and abandon the well since our operations during the past year have proved to be unprofitable. The "D" sand was acidized with mud acid and fractured. These treatments failed to stimulate a sustained increase in oil production.
- The well has the following amounts of casing in place:

10-3/4"	29#	573'	300	sax cement
5 1/2"	15.5#	6,260'	200	sax cement
- The well will be plugged in accordance with the general rules and regulations of the Oil & Gas Conservation Commission, State of Colorado. Please indicate any special instructions you wish to be followed in the abandonment procedure.
