The distance from the proposed wellbore to nearest existing or proposed wellbore belonging to another operator, including plugged wells was measured to the DA Kerr McGee HSR Cherry Knolls 9-33. No stimulation setback consent is not required because the offset well is D&A'd.

Changes to this well are landing point, bottom hole, casing and cement program.

The oil and gas location has been built and has a producing well on it.

The 2A was amended in July of 2019 with updated Best Management Practices (BMP"s), per the director's objective criteria.

1	Drilling/Completion Operations	Logging: The Judy 3-4, API No. 05-123-50294, well drilled on the pad was logged with an open-hole Resistivity Log and Gamma Ray Log from the kick-off point into the surface casing. All wells on the pad will have a cement bond log with gamma-ray run on production casing (or on intermediate casing if production liner is run) into the surface casing. The horizontal portion of every well will be logged with a measured-while-drilling gamma-ray log. The Form 5, Completion Report, for each well on the pad will list all logs run and have those logs attached. The Form 5 for a well without open-hole logs shall clearly state "No open-hole logs were run. The Buford 33-9-3L, API No. 05-123-45544, is the well in which open-hole logs were run.
2	Drilling/Completion Operations	Anti-collision: Operator will perform an anti-collision evaluation of all active (producing, shut in, or temporarily abandoned) offset wellbores that have the potential of being within 150 feet of a proposed well prior to drilling operations for the proposed well. Notice shall be given to all offset operators prior to drilling.
3	Drilling/Completion Operations	Bradenhead Monitoring: Operator acknowledges and will comply with COGCC Policy for Braden-head Monitoring during Hydraulic Fracturing Treatments in the Greater Wattenberg Area dated May 29, 2012.
