Previous inspection observed noxious weed (musk thistle) establishment on the Location and required Operator to comply with Rule 1004.e. It was observed in this inspection that noxious weed management appears to have been conducted. Corrective action has been addressed. Continue to conduct weed monitoring and management on the Location until final reclamation has passed.

Previous inspection required Operator to conduct reclamation on a freshwater pit utilized for Trail Ridge drilling operations. After additional review it has been determined that this corrective action will no longer be applicable.
