The exposed line where soil compacted was buried with gravel from an existing stockpile.

The other inspection finding was in regard to the ditch onsite. The ditch is sloped toward a settling pond that allows sediment from water runoff to settle out before evaporating. The ditch was not altered and is functioning as designed.

Not Approved

Comment seems to be saying that BMPs were not repaired/maintained. Seasonal maintenance and cleaning of BMPs is normally indicated after snowmelt and spring runoff.
