Thank you for using the COGCC Online Tool to file your complaint.
Your information has been entered into document number 200449139.

I have reviewed the location described in your complaint and it is a midstream compressor station, which is not within the jurisdiction of COGCC. The Public Utilities Commission has jurisdiction over safety at this facility, but they do not have rules regarding noise. As such, your local government would likely be the entity with regulatory authority over noise.

COGCC staff did not identify any violations of COGCC rules that would lead to the issuance of a notice of alleged violation (NOAV) related to your complaint. Accordingly, the COGCC has closed your complaint.
