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Photo 1. It appears noxious weeds were controlled along the road. Some of the grass vegetation appears to be browning as well.



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Photo 2. There is a plugged culvert along the main road (red arrow) causing stormwater to flow down the road. Lat/Long:37.09178,-104.93688.



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Photo 3. There is sediment accumulation at the bottom of the road which appears to be coming uphill from the access road or pipeline area.



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Photo 4. BMP's are needed along the side of the road to dissipate stormwater flow.



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Photo 5. Stormwater is flowing down the road which is causing erosion and degradation of the road.



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Photo 6. The culvert is plugged up along the road causing stormwater to flow down the road as shown in the previous photo.
