1	<p>Hello,</p> <p>I am writing to request that you do not approve the natural gas wells at Point Three 11-16HZ (Permit Number 402405790).</p> <p>I live in Pioneer Ridge and I am concerned that having 12 wells and a production facility within 2000 feet of so many homes will negatively affect myself and my neighbors.</p> <p>My concerns are:</p> <p>Property values</p> <p>Increased traffic</p> <p>Air pollution</p> <p>Water contamination</p> <p>Noise pollution</p> <p>I am also concerned that KerrMcGee is requesting the permit. They have a history cutting corners and ignoring regulations in the pursuit of profit. They were fined over 5 billion dollars by the Department of Justice for damaging the environment and trying to stick the American taxpayer with the bill. Deputy Attorney General James Cole is quoted as saying "Kerr-McGee's businesses all over this country left significant, lasting environmental damage in their wake". Your own commission fined them over 18 million in April for the Firestone explosion.</p> <p>KerrMcGee has the record for the largest fine ever from both the Department of Justice and the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission.
