Good Afternoon,

This message is being sent to you in regard to an oil and gas well pad location known as the Sheley 1. Please allow this email to serve as notice for a release that occurred on 20 January 2021, at Crestone Peak Resources, Sheley 1 battery (COGCC Location ID 479236), located at the latitude/longitude of 40163573, -104.899443. While a lease operator was walking the location for a site inspection, he noticed fluid coming up from the ground around a pipe inside a separator cabinet. Upon further investigation, he discovered that the fluid was likely production water coming to the surface from a pipe or fitting failure underground. This has recently been confirmed while using a Hydro-vac truck on location to remove contaminated soil. Our third party environmental contractor has taken soil samples around the area to confirm the extent of the impact as we continue to work to remediate the soil.
