Lynn, Thank you for the quick response this morning. I can provide verbal approval to utilize a 3 string casing design as discussed this week and outlined in your email. In line with the BLM requirements, the cement COA is listed below and a CBL is not required on the intermediate casing. Once you have the first form 4 sundry completed, leave it in Draft mode and let me know the document number. I can review the new sections such as the potential flow zone table and provide feedback prior to submitting.

Cement COA: Operator shall provide cement coverage from the intermediate casing shoe (9 5/8" FIRST STRING) to a minimum of 500' above the top of the Wasatch formation.

Per our discussion today TEP's requests a verbal approval for a three string contingency well design change for the last 11 wells on the RG 41-18-297 pad. This email and your reply would serve as a verbal approval.

No changes to the Production hole section.

Revised well bore diagram attached.

Hole design:

Surface hole size 17.5" to ~1400' MD and approx. 200' above Dissolution Surface.

Surface casing – 13.375", J-55, BTC, 54.5#

Intermediate hole size – 12.25" to TD 500' into the Wasatch same as permitted.

Intermediate casing – 9.625", J-55, LTC, 36# is the same specs as permitted.

Cement design:

Surface Casing – 12.3# Single stage slurry with 40% excess

Intermediate – Single stage slurry

12.3# Lead with TOC ~500' MD above the Wasatch with 50% excess.

12.8# Tail from TD to 500' above float shoe.

Well and API# for the proposal change on 11 wells.
