Well has been plugged previously, per COGCC doc #399337. The COGCC Orphan Well Program will verify cement to surface in all annuli with additional cementing as needed and will cut, cap, and bury well per COGCC rules and guidelines. COGCC Orphan Well Program will decommission any associated flowline. Soil samples will be collected in accordance with COGCC Rule 911.a(4) Guidance Document. Samples will be collected from the wellhead excavation and any encountered flowline path and submitted for laboratory analysis of Table 915-1 constituents.
