1 Wildlife	<p>Based on the wildlife maps, this location falls within High Priority Habitat for Mule Deer Severe Winter Range, Pronghorn Antelope Winter Concentration Areas, and Plains Sharp-Tailed Grouse Production Areas. Based on this information, the following five wildlife BMPs for Mule Deer, Pronghorn Antelope, and Plains Sharp-Tailed Grouse species-specific are required for this location:</p> <p>If new oil and gas operations must occur within CPW-mapped mule deer severe winter range, the operator agrees to conduct new oil and gas operations outside the time period from December 1 through April 30.</p> <p>The operator and its contractors will attempt to restrict routine well site visitations to portions of the day between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. during the winter season (December 1 through April 30) within CPW-mapped mule deer severe winter range.</p> <p>If oil and gas operations must occur within pronghorn winter concentration areas, the operator agrees to preclude new oil and gas operations from January 1 through April 30.</p> <p>If oil and gas operations must occur within production areas or within 1.25 miles of plains sharp-tailed grouse leks, the operator agrees to conduct oil and gas operations outside the period between March 1 and June 30.</p> <p>The operator and its contractors agree to restrict well site visitations to no more than once per day, and to portions of the day between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. during the leking, nesting and brood rearing seasons (March 1 to June 30) within production areas or within 1.25 miles of a lek site.</p>
