Operator Comment: This well was plugged in June 2020. All COAs were properly completed.
Proper Form 27s were filed and approved. Form 27 Doc # 402534556 Dated 11/18/2020:
"Based on the information presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time and the COGCC approves the closure request."

In addition:

- a. The equipment, access road or any associated r-o-w referred to in the failed inspection does not belong to Petron or the former owners of the well and well site. These belong to the gatherer.
- b. This is CRP ground (virtually no maintenance by surface owner).
- c. The site has been reseeded twice. Given we are in a severe drought period, seedlings are having a rough time taking hold.
- d. Per Rule 1004(c),2 "disturbed areas have been either built on, compacted, covered, paved, or otherwise stabilized in such a way as to minimize erosion to the extent practicable...". This has been completed.
- e. Petron was a contract operator. Petron's contract with any potential interest owners has been terminated. Petron has no legal right to represent any potential interest owners in this expired lease.
- f. This lease has expired. No operator would have authority to reenter the location (a.k.a, trespassing).

No action will be taken by the former operator and Petron requests this inspection be cleared and the final status reflect a passed final inspection.
