## **REMEDIATION SUMMARY**

Excavation will be performed to remove all impacted soil. Impacted soil will be disposed of at the Front Range Landfill in Erie, CO. Excavation activities are scheduled to begin October 2021. Following the completion of excavation activities, soil samples will be collected.  
1) Excavation activities will stop to collect soil samples. It is estimated soil sampling will be scheduled for the week of October 19, 2021.  
2) Soil samples will be sent to lab for analysis. Lab analysis estimated to be completed by October 25, 2021.  
3) If samples are compliance with Table 915-1 thresholds, KPK will submit results for review. Supplemental Form 27 submittal estimated to be submitted by October 29, 2021. If sample results are not compliant KPK will resume excavation activities.
