3rd party pumper notified SOCC of a possible line leak on the PN 30 (2" line). SOCC called on call pipeline operator who went to location and confirmed the leak. Line was blocked in on both sides (approximately 100'). Due to the block and the hole the line naturally blew down. No estimate of amount of product released is currently available and size of hole is undetermined because it is a buried pipeline. Line was blocked in with excavation and repairs to be scheduled.
