I am concerned about the BPZ on this well, Harold 6Y-312 (API 123-45752). The WSU as approved was extremely tight and the BHL/BPZ ended up 14' further south than planned.

Please confirm the BPZ/BHL with validated data such as a survey plat to show that the 460' WSU setback hasn't been pushed into NWNW Section 10 4N 64W by the completion.
