Paul Nelson

- 3/9/21 - Oxy sends an initial inquiry to CPW.
- 3/31/21 - Oxy holds a site visit with CPW.
 - Oxy Representatives: Sam Samet, Emma Vannoy, Joseph Riemer and representative of the surface owner also attended
 - CPW Representatives: Brandon Marette, Michael Grooms, Boyd Wright, and Angelique Curtis
 - We discussed alternative locations within the DSU and ended up back at this preferred location (e.g., one alternative discussed was if Oxy could examine if they could push the well and facility pads to the east of the yellow-dashed aquatic 500' buffer? The challenge with moving the pad to east is the setback from the house and there is also a raptors nest located on the property.)
- 4/27/21 -
 - CPW is more concerned about the impacts to mule deer severe winter range habitat than the location being within the Native Aquatic Species buffer (due to Oxy's site Stormwater Management Plan). Oxy said they would avoid impacting the winter season (12/1-4/30).
 - CPW held internal meetings and got back to Oxy with direct and indirect mitigation options. Oxy chose to pay the mitigation fees.
- 7/20/21 - Noise plan e-mails between Oxy & CPW.
- 7/27/21 - 300-500' waiver request e-mails between Oxy & CPW.
- 7/28/21 - WOGLA call with Weld County, Oxy & CPW
- 8/12/21 - Oxy said remote 24/7 sensors should limit human presence during winter months. Oxy also sent CPW WOGLA notice of intent.
- 9/17/21 - CPW waived daily monitoring requirement.
- 11/5/21 - Oxy asked for CPW's help in summarizing consultation history (CPW responded on 11/15).
- 12/2/21 - CPW response to Weld County is due (sent 11/4).

- 8/12/20 - Oxy initially asked CPW about this access road within the 1/2-mile Bald Eagle buffer.
- 3/31/21 - Oxy holds a site visit with CPW after the Paul Nelson site visit since we were in the vicinity already.
 - Oxy Representatives: Sam Samet, Emma Vannoy, Joseph Riemer and representative of the surface owner also attended
 - CPW Representatives: Brandon Marette, Michael Grooms, Boyd Wright, and Angelique Curtis
