Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

We propose to plug and abandon the captioned well by placing cement from total depth (5065 feet) to 4768 feet opposite the Muddy and Dakota sandstone and to a point 95 feet above the top of the 'Muddy' sandstone. Then heavy mud taken from the bottom of the mud pit will be placed from 4768 feet to 480 where a cement plug will be spotted to 393 feet (opposite the bottom of the surface casing). Then heavy mud will be placed from 393 feet to within 15 feet of the surface, where a cement plug will be placed to the surface in such a manner as not to interfere with surface cultivation. Verbal approval to plug and abandon this well was granted to Mr. A. H. Wieder, Shell Division Exploitation Engineer, by Mr. J. J. Zorichak, Director of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission by phone on July 9, 1952.
