Gentlemen:

The Skelly Oil Company wishes to file with the Commission an application granting permission and authority to dually complete its G. A. Henderson Well No. 5, located in the NE/4 SW/4 NW/4 of Section 18, Township 9 North, Range 53 West, Logan, Colorado and commingle production from the 1st. Dakota "D" and 3rd. Dakota "J" sands into one well bore.

The pressures in the two formations have declined to such a point that no "thieving" will result. The pump capacity will be greater than the oil capacity of both zones, preventing the thieving of oil from either zone to the other. A maximum of fifty barrels of oil is expected from the "J" zone in addition to the present twenty barrels of oil from the "D" zone. Economics do not warrant the installation of two separate tubing strings in a single casing.

According to Cause No. 149 and Order No. 149-1, before the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, dated October 18, 1960, and concerning Skelly Oil Company's G. A. Henderson Well No. 4, in Logan County, Colorado, under Rule 2, "Similar dual completions and commingling in one well bore in other wells in the Cedar Creek Field may be approved and authorized by this Commission, as provided by the rules and regulations of this Commission."
