



Gentlemen:

We have received your request of December 30, 1963 for a Form 10, "Certificate of Clearance", on the subject well. This well has been temporarily abandoned and it is the intention of the Operator to further test it at some future date.

Approximately 300 barrels of oil were produced from the well during the testing period. However, since no treatment facilities were available on the lease it could not be treated to pipeline specifications. It was necessary to make a distressed sale of this oil to a local supplier of frac oil.

In light of this information would you please notify us if it will be necessary to file a Form 10 for the oil which we produced during the testing period in order to complete your records.
