Attached please find the Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) for the subject Wellington Operating Company (WOC) facility for November 2021.

**The late filing of this report was a result of delays in getting the required laboratory analysis from ALS. I reported this to you in an email dated December 28, 2021. I received the reports late on December 31, 2021 and uploaded them on the weekend.**

**The facility did operate and discharge treated wastewater during the month of November 2021. A compliance sample was collected and analyzed during November 2021 and the laboratory data is attached. As expected, the barium and fluoride exceed the new discharge limits but the month of November is within my compliance schedule. No other analyzed parameters exceeded their discharge limits**

**An annual sample for PFAS was collected at Outfall 001A with a split being collected by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC). The sample collected by WOC was analyzed by ALS Laboratory and Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA) at 0.76 parts per trillion and no other parameters were detected in the sample and the results were qualified as "J - Analyte detected below quantitation limits". This sample data will be submitted separately once a working EDD file is received from ALS.**


**Quarterly samples for the fourth quarter were collected and analyzed from the existing five monitoring wells and the laboratory data is attached.**

**As requested, WOC has prepared and attached a copy of a water balance sheet for the Wellington Produced Treatment facility and the Wellington Muddy Sand Stone Unit – South Battery for November 2021. This water balance is being submitted voluntarily and is not required by the current discharge permit.**

Mr. Randy Evans is the current operator in responsible charge for the facility.
