Nature of complaint: Complainant indicated that the well location/associated tank battery location is too high and not level to irrigate the lower part of the field.

Comments

COGCC Staff was unable to make an accurate assessment to identify the complainants concern due to the time of year. COGCC Staff makes assessments based on vegetative conditions. Since vegetation has started to undergone senescence, it was too difficult to determine plant health.

COGCC Staff will coordinate with the surface owner next Spring to observe active flood irrigation and to assess vegetative conditions in the area of concern (lower part of the field off location) during the active growing season.
