

TOTAL DEPTH 4996'. 10 3/4" CASING WAS SET AT 249' AND CEMENTED WITH 200 SACKS OF CEMENT. HOLE WAS FILLED WITH HEAVY MUD. A 50 SACK CEMENT PLUG WAS PLACED 311' TO 201'. A 25 SACK CEMENT PLUG WAS PLACED IN TOP OF SURFACE CASING. A METAL CAP WAS WELDED IN TOP OF CASING AND A 3" x 4' LENGTH OF PIPE ERECTED FOR A MARKER. WELL PLUGGED AND ABANDON AT 3:30 P.M. 7-8-54.
