Comment Previous inspections documented noxious weeds (Bull thistle, Musk thistle) established on the Location. Inspections required Operator to comply with 1003.f.

Limited visibility due to snow cover prevented an accurate assessment of the reclamation area. One single bull thistle was observed, however residual noxious weeds from the 2021 growing season, and dense weed patches previously documented were not observed; ongoing noxious weed management appears to be occurring.

Continue to monitor and manage Location for Undesirable Plant Species.
