Dear Mr. Stanley,

I'm writing today to provide affirmation to the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) that Verdad Resources LLC (Verdad) has been working with USDA Forest Service (USFS) to secure a permit for access to enter and remediate the plug on two locations, ST JOHNS CATHOLIC CHURCH #41-31 (API 05-123-19872) and FEDERAL PERRY #13-32 (API 05-123-13640), on the Pawnee National Grassland in Weld County, Colorado.

Verdad has met nearly all the requirements needed to secure a permit and I expect the USFS will issue said permit authorizing access to the above locations within the next week. To clarify, this permit only addresses access and associated resource protection design/mitigation for use and occupancy of the Pawnee National Grassland.
