Comment

Previous inspection #702800196 observed noxious weeds are widespread on the Location, although not dominant. Inspector required Operator to Conduct weed management to prevent further establishment and spread of CO State List B Noxious Weeds by 5/25/2022.

It was observed in this inspection that some weeds on Location show evidence of herbicide damage. It appears that noxious weeds have been treated and that this corrective action has been addressed. No Field Inspection Report Resolution Form (FIRR) has been received as required per Rule 210.a. Many noxious weeds were observed to be untreated, including dalmatian toadflax and Canada thistle. Additional management is required.

Comply with Rule 1003.f and conduct weed management on the Location to prevent further establishment and spread of CO State List B Noxious Weeds; ongoing weed management required.
