Comment:	It was observed in this inspection that ongoing weed monitoring/management to control noxious weeds has been inadequate on the Location; Jointed Goatgrass (<i>Aegilops cylindrica</i>) has established throughout the majority of the Location and access road; plants have matured and seeds have already shattered/spread; infestation likely due to impacted mulch used during reclamation. Ongoing weed management required.		
Corrective Action:	Comply with Rules 1004.e and 606.c. Collaborate with an expert to determine appropriate strategies in order to manage weeds and implement ongoing weed management efforts in order to control, contain and prevent the further spread and establishment of Undesirable and Noxious Plant species both on and from the Location. <p>RECLAMATION</p> <p>Inspection #696202784 (6/8/2021) observed that final reclamation work, including removal of gravel, compaction alleviation, recontouring/regrading and revegetation activities have not been conducted at Location and access road; well abandoned 2/18/2019, reclamation work was required to be completed by 2/18/2020. Inspection required Operator to comply with 1004 rules.</p> <p>Operator submitted resolution #402851367 stating 1004 reclamation work was completed 10/24/2021.</p> <p>It was observed in this inspection that reclamation work has not been completed in accordance with 1004.a; gravel has not been remove and compaction issues remain evident at access road. It was also observed that noxious weed issues exist, and desirable plant germination on the Location does not appear to be uniform; though some germination is evident, the location predominantly annual wheat and rye grasses, or noxious weeds.</p> <p>See "Good Housekeeping" for corrective action regarding noxious weed infestation.</p>	trujilloam	07/22/2022
