The elevation above sea level is 4216 ft. K.B. and 4206 ft. gd.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

After drilling firm cement from 4850 to 4917 with 7" casing cemented at 4930 perforations were placed in the casing opposite the oil bearing sand. On January 12, 1951, Lane-Wells shot 108 holes evenly spaced, 2 inches apart from 4888 to 4906 with 15/32" steel bullets. Swabbing then began through tubing. After 85 barrels of oil was swabbed from the hole, the well began flowing. From 12:30 P.M. January 14, 1951, to 9:45 P.M. January 14, 1951, the well flowed 343 barrels of clean oil. During the last 6 hour period, the rate of flow was 44 barrels per hour open flow for a calculated IP of 1056 barrels per day.
