Comment:

Refer to the "Location" section of this inspection report for weed control and trash/debris corrective action.

This location does not meet reclamation requirements; insufficient vegetative cover. Perennial plants are uncommon, while annual plants are widespread. Kochia (undesirable plant species) dominates the plant community, Cheatgrass (List C Noxious) is occasional, halogeton (List C Noxious) is common. Seeding appears to have failed. Seeded perennial grasses (western wheatgrass) are rare.

Corrective Action:

Comply with 1004 Rules.

Conduct additional reclamation in accordance with COGCC 1000 series rules. Establish vegetation with total perennial, non-invasive uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels on the Location and access road. Use a seed mixture requested by the surface owner, or a mixture prescribed by the local soil conservation district. Ensure erosion controls are implemented to stabilize the seeded soil, and continue to monitor and manage this site until Final Reclamation has passed. Revegetation activities shall be completed no later than 11/15/2022.
