Areas of concentrated flow (slope drain, sediment trap inlet/outlet) have been lined with geotextile fabric and smooth river rock. Smooth rock can accelerate water flow around rocks and may contribute to degradation. BMPs shall be maintained until the facility is abandoned and final reclamation is achieved pursuant to Rule 1004.</p>
