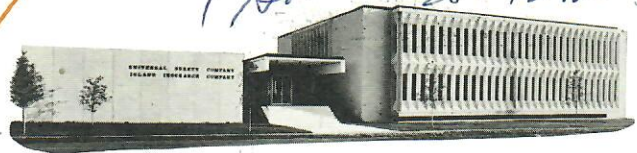

\$10,000 Blanket Oil & Gas Operator's Bond

Gentlemen:

Under date of December 21, 1966 the above captioned bond was furnished by our company and filed with your department.

It is our understanding that this firm presently needs bond coverage for only one well - namely Antelope Gas Products Company No. 1 Federal Well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 28, T. 12, N. Range 55 West, Ramrod Field, Logan County, Colorado. The firm is under the impression that they must have a \$5,000 bond on file covering this well. In reading your Rules and Regulations booklet, it would appear that a bond for only \$2,500 would suffice. *(now increase)*

We would greatly appreciate it if you would check your records and advise us if single well bond can be filed, to replace the blanket bond, and, if so, should it be in amount of \$5,000 or \$2,500?

We would also appreciate your advising us the procedure for cancellation of the blanket bond if the single well bond is filed in lieu thereof. Will you, automatically, forward our company a letter exonerating us from further liability under the blanket bond?
