Dear Mr. Davidson:

As you requested, Fremont Environmental Inc. (Fremont) personnel removed four soil vapor monitoring points that were present adjacent to the former Edstrom 24-8 wellhead. These ¼" diameter tubing vapor points were approximately three feet deep and completed at the surface with 2" diameter PVC protective covers.

Fremont personnel removed the protective covers, tubing and the bentonite seal material from each of the four vapor points. Each vapor point was then backfilled with surrounding soil. Photos of the vapor points and abandonment work are attached.
