A historical release was discovered during decommission activities at the CPC 42-23 1 wellhead in Adams County. A total of 40 cubic yards was removed for cut and cap activities. The stockpile exceeded COGCC standards for TPH and will be transported to a certified landfill for disposal. The excavations sidewalls and base will be sampled to determine if impacts remain above standard in the excavation.
