Dear Mr. Smith:

Responsive to your letter of March 17th. I visited the well site on Sunday and have also checked with some of the men familiar with this drilling operation.

If you will recall, there was some question as to which was the well site. From the information I have obtained and from my memory, the actual well site was adjacent on the West to the two mud tanks and reservoir.

Upon checking this I find that no hole exists, only some old bracings that were there last year. This I filled to some extent Sunday leaving a lesser depression in the ground.

As to the hole, some 30 feet to the South, which was thought might possibly have been the original well, I find upon probing, that this hole was only some 20 to 30 feet deep. This I plugged with an additional 8 by 8 and filled to the surface. What this hole is nobody seems to know, but it definitely is not part of the original drilling operation.
