Operator Comment: As described in the associated Form 4 final reclamation sundry notice (Document # 403143264), the pig launcher/receiver and associated access will be removed and reclaimed when the pipeline is abandoned in the future. There are no plans to abandon the pipeline currently, as it services the K35NW pad (Loc. ID 334942) upstream and the I3B (Loc. ID 334911) and A10WB (Loc. ID 334921) well pads downstream. The 8" gas line runs

from the K35NW pad to the Pumba Compressor Station. All portions of the line specific to the L35 location (risers, etc.) have been removed. The pig launcher/receiver is necessary for routine pipeline maintenance to maintain the infrastructure in proper functioning condition. The 150-foot road spur and turn-around are needed for pig launcher access. Caerus requests concurrence from the COGCC that this road section and the pig launcher are associated with the pipeline, not Location ID 334828."

COGCC Decision: Approved pending re-inspection

COGCC Representative: Approved pending re-inspection of this FIR resolution acknowledges the document was received. It is not an acknowledgement that the corrective action has been passed. COGCC acknowledges that the pig launcher/receiver and associated access are associated with the pipeline and not Location #334828. A field inspection will be conducted at a future date to evaluate compliance with COGCC rules, and to evaluate compliance with corrective actions and comments from inspection document #702800571.
