Gentlemen:

This is written with reference to your Supplementary Application filed with this office on November 24, 1959, for the disposal of unfit water produced with the oil from the Pierce Field.

Rule 328 (K) of this Commission's Rules and Regulations states, in part, that in the event no owners of record within one-half mile of the disposal well, or the Commission itself, files written objection or complaint to the application within fifteen days of the date of the application, then the application shall be granted.

Having received no objections, you are hereby authorized to inject said unfit water from the Pierce Field into the Lakota formation, in addition to the Entrada formation, through the Gertrude L. King #2 well located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 8 North, Range 66 West, as outlined in your Supplementary Application.
