Gentlemen:

It has been noted that you are drilling a well located in Section 10, T. 9N., R. 78W., Jackson County, Colorado.

Although this location is on government land, approval to drill should also be obtained from this office. The rules and regulations of the Commission (rule 303) state that approval to drill must be obtained regardless of whether land is Patented or Federal (including Indian lands). This location is within the spaced area of the Canadian River Field. The footage of your well which we have been informed as being 660' from south section line and 1980' from the east section line meet this requirement. However, enclosed for your information are the two orders issued by the Commission concerning drilling and producing operations in this field.

Also enclosed for your convenience is a copy of the Rules and Regulations and a supply of the various forms necessary to file with this office. OCCC Form 2, Notice of Intention to Drill should still be filed as a matter of record. A copy of the Federal government forms showing progress and/or completion of the well will be acceptable in lieu of our own forms.
