Dear Mr. Girouard:

Reference is made to your letter of June 10, 1957, regarding the anticipated location of a well to be drilled 200 feet from the east line and 1520 feet from the north line of Section 10, Township 9 North, Range 78 West of the 6th P. M., Jackson County, Colorado.

Please be advised that Rule 1a of Order 96-1 cannot be amended without notice and hearing, however, the rule specifically states that exception to the permitted well location may be granted upon the filing with the Commission of waiver or consent in writing signed by the lease owner toward whom the well location is proposed to be moved, agreeing that said well may be located at the point to which the owner proposes to drill the well.

As stated in your letter, your company and the Continental Oil Company are the only owners concerned and waivers have been signed by both. Therefore, the well location will be approved when the Form 2 (Notice of Intention to Drill) is formally submitted.
