

It is proposed to drill this well to test the Arbuckle formation which is expected to be found at approximately 5850 ft. 200 ft. of 10 3/4" OD, 32.75# pipe will be set for surface casing and cemented to the surface. If sufficient indication of commercially productive fluid is found, a 5 1/2" OD, 14# J-55 string of casing will be set and cemented.
