Mr. Cruson,

We performed the following work on the above lease. Please attach this letter to a Form 4 for the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission, as the cement verification. I was contacted by Mr. Ed Dimattio with the Commission on November 17th. He indicated that since I was not a designated agent, I could not file a Form 4 for your company. I had done this on October 21, per our verbal agreement. It is therefore necessary for you to refile the Form 4.

Dumped sand to cover the perforations.  
Dumped 5 sacks of cement, tagged sand at 4700 with bailer.  
Loaded the hole, and cut casing at 1,600'.  
Set 25 sacks of cement 1/2 in and 1/2 out of surface at 60'.  
Set 5 sacks at surface.  
Cut the wellhead off 4' down, and welded a plate.  
Backfilled the hole, and dug the deadmen.  
The West Fork Unit is still producing, so the production battery was not dismantled.
