Dear Sir:

The Tipps No. 1-"B" Pierce well, located in the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 3, Township 3South, Range 56 West, Cone Field, Washington County, Colorado, was first drilled by Continental Oil Co. to a total depth of 5432 feet, and plugged and abandoned on or about August 8, 1956.

In January 1958, Kenneth Tipps re-entered this well, and on February 1, 1958, production of oil from the "J" sand began.

This well was eventually plugged and abandoned on August 24, 1960, after producing 8923 barrels of oil. Production for the month of December 1958 was 389 barrels; for January 1959 - 205 barrels, and for February 1959 - 7 barrels.
