During flowback operations approximately 210 bbls of produced water was released to the pad surface, some of which was contained within secondary lined containment. The spill was contained to the pad surface and has been controlled. Prior to freezing, 70 bbls were recovered. The impacted soil will be removed and hauled to a COGCC approved disposal facility. Confirmation soil samples will be collected and submitted for laboratory analysis of Table 915-1 constituents. An internal root cause analysis will be conducted by Crestone Peak Resources.
