This confirms the telephone conversation of September 10, 1974 between Mr. J. M. Galovich and you concerning our request to temporarily flare gas at the subject location.

Kodak Well No. 1 is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T6N, R67W, Weld County, Colorado. The well is presently being completed in the "J" sand and it will be necessary to flare gas during this phase of our operations.

Current plans are to test the well for approximately thirty days. The flare is expected to be clean burning with little or no smoke involved. The flare will be contained and all practical safety and pollution prevention measures will be taken. Current plans are to have the well completed by October 20, 1974, at which time the flare will cease.
