On Monday, 5/22/2023, Inspector Kirby Burchett, conducted a routine field inspection at POC-I LLC on the Iles Dome Unit 24 well, Location #312848, in Moffat County, Colorado. This location is within or in close proximity to a Parks and Wildlife (CPW) District with High Priority, NSO, and Density Habitat regulations. Any Corrective Actions from previous Inspections are still applicable.

While there during normal operations the following compliance issues were observed:

1. Debris.
2. Stained soil.
3. Bradenhead not visible.
4. Chemical tank not labeled.
5. Well sign missing required information.
6. Containment without wildlife protection.
7. Stormwater BMPs need implementation.

A follow up on this site inspection will be conducted to ensure all compliance issues have been corrected to comply with COGCC rules.
