Gentlemen:

In reply to your letter of July 16, 1969, I regret that I will be unable to get the above captioned well plugged by the deadline date of August 15, 1969 set by you, however I assure you that it will be done on or before premium paying time for the bond, same being September 8, 1969.

With your permission and approval the following procedure will be followed in the plugging of this well.

Since the 547 feet of hole drilled in this well was solid sandy lime rock, I propose to fill the hole with ready mix cement to be furnished out of Trinidad, Colorado, then cut off the surface casing to the required 18 inches below the surface of the ground and weld a cap thereon. The location will then be restored to as near as is possible to its original condition.

I want to at this time to thank you for your past courtesies and considerations and hope that the time and procedure for the plugging of the Veltri #1 meets with your approval.
