Reference is made to your letter of Sept. 29 regarding the well numbering system for the Rosen Oil Company leases and wells in the Rangely area. To use the same number for each well makes it hopelessly confusing for us and our records; therefore I propose the following system which will maintain a numerical sequence for each lease and will help us to keep our records straight:

(By using the last three numbers in the lease number to precede the well number, we can identify the well without describing the location or identifying the full number of the lease.)

Thus our Rosen No. 1 well becomes Rosen 804-1,
and our Rosen No. 2 well becomes Rosen #682-1,

If the above system meets your approval, please change the numbers of the wells accordingly.
