Dear Stewart:

Your secretary has probably told you that I attempted to call you yesterday regarding information on some of your wells. She advised that you were staying at the Brown-Palace but I did not feel my request warranted my bothering you there.

My prime concern is with the old Union Oil of California's #1 Ivory located in Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 97 West, Rio Blanco County, Colorado. The last information we have on the well was a completion report filed in 1954, with the following note: "If it is agreeable, we would like to refer you to Mr. McLaughlin for any further information regarding this well." Could you please let us know if anything has ever been done to this hole?

With regard to your own wells, it is a matter of status or current plans, and we would like this information on the following wells:

McLaughlin #34 and #62
✓ Federal #1-16 ✓
Patented #29
University of Texas #1

We appreciate the fact that some of these are relatively new intentions, as Rangely-Mancos goes, but it is imperative that we check the situation on all wells from time to time.

As you know, we now accept copies of Federal forms and this should make your reporting to us easier.

If we do not hear from you by December 1, I will contact your office by 'phone and would appreciate your leaving the information regarding each of the above-mentioned wells with your secretary. Your prompt cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated.
