DETAILS OF WORK

We have pulled the 5" pipe and are presently pulling the 7" casing. 100' of 8" surface pipe will remain in the hole as the cement was circulated.

The hole will be filled with heavy mud. A forty foot cement plug will be set at the bottom of the 8" surface casing and will extend 20' below the casing.

A forty foot cement plug will be placed at the top of the surface casing and a 10' joint of 5" pipe will be placed in this plug for a marker. The marker will show the name of the operator, lease name, and legal description of the lease. It will be painted silver.
