Receipt of your letter in answer to ours of August 21, 1961, is hereby acknowledged and appreciated.

First, let me say that Mr. Bradley has not yet been in our office nor made any contact other than a return receipt (which was signed by his wife) of our letter of the above date.

As to information you might furnish us on the No. 2 Globe Guccini in the SE SW SW, Section 12, what we need on this well is a completion report, OGCC Form 5, and an electric log, if available. I have enclosed some Form 5's.

On the No. 1 Barcus well, we need an OGCC Form 10, Certificate of Clearance, as well as OGCC Form 7's, Operator's Monthly Production Report, for the months in which the well produced. Apparently, the Barcus well has not been plugged as yet, so your bond cannot be released until such time as Mr. Bradley puts up a bond, or the well is plugged and abandoned and all requirements of this office are met.
