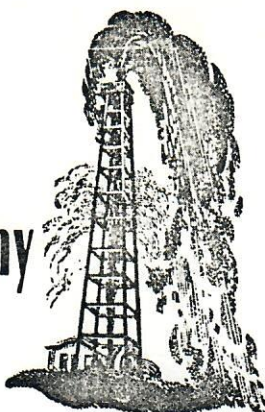

Gentlemen:

Your letter of August 15, 1975 at hand. We are inclosing Form 9-329 on Well #40, on Lease C-034894 in Rio Blanco County, Colorado which should bring it up to-date. We intend to put this well on the pump as soon as we file a Sundry Notice and also a rig is available.

The Wells, #52, 26A, 22A, 29A, 28A, 30A, 19, 36A, 43, 44 and 49 are all abandoned wells with markers in place.

Petrel Oil Corp., at the request of Rudolph C. Baier, Jr. who was acting District Engineer at the time had Petrel Oil Corp., abandon these wells. We do not have those files in our office as this lease was in Petrel Oil Corp., name at that time, therefore those files belong to Petrel Oil Corp.

Well #19 was cleaned out in 1973 and LuBauer Petroleum will put this well on the pump also as soon as a rig is available.
