Gentlemen:

We are returning the approved copy of the intent to repair for the above mentioned well.

A check of our records, however, indicates that we have never received an intent to drill this well nor the \$75.00 drilling fee.

Approval to drill should be obtained from this office prior to the commencement of drilling regardless as whether the well location is on Fee, State, or Federal and Indian lands. This also applies to the drilling fee which has been in effect since July 1964. Failure to comply is in violation of the Rules and Regulation of the Commission.

Although the well was drilled almost two years ago, an intent to drill with the drilling fee should still be submitted.

Also enclosed are copies of the plugging report for well No. 29-A. This well was also drilled without prior approval in 1956.
